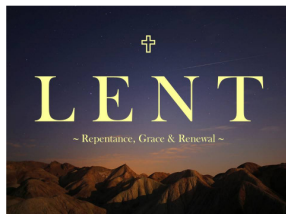

The food donated will be collected on the last Sunday of each month and delivered to the food bank on the following Monday.

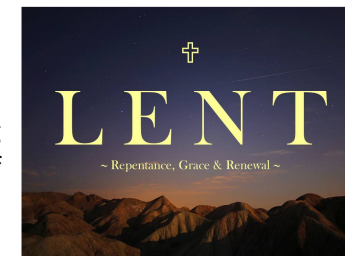
